As we prepare to welcome your child into the Wallington County Grammar School community, we are filled with excitement for the journey ahead. We take immense pride in nurturing not just academic excellence, but also well-rounded individuals who will go on to achieve incredible things in their lifetimes.

We are committed to providing an outstanding education that equips our students with the skills, knowledge, and experiences they need to compete with the very best. However, as a selective school, our government funding is limited. It is through the ongoing generosity of parents that the school is able to maintain and enhance the opportunities available to our students.

For just £1 a day – less than the price of a cup of coffee – you can make an incredible difference. A contribution of **£35 per month** (or whatever you feel able to give) will help us continue providing the enriching experiences that set Wallington County Grammar School apart.

Your contribution to the School Fund directly supports:

- The continuation of over 30 clubs and societies, including Med Prep, Oxbridge Club, Girls Active, and Computer Programming Society.
- The delivery of our unique Politics, Philosophy, and Economics curriculum for 450 students in Years 8-10.
- The staffing and running of rugby, cricket, and table tennis teams across all year groups.
- The Extended Project Qualification, enabling Sixth Formers to undertake independent research projects.
- The maintenance of our school's sporting facilities at Clockhouse and the staffing of Saturday sporting fixtures.
